## Vehicle Interior

Function check -

Check and adjust battery levels

## Wheels & Brakes

Brake test - by dynamometer or road test

Remove & install wheels, rotate **but not where tyres are mixed**

Remove right front wheel, (& rear - A190/210) check pads and discs.

Check rear brake lining thickness via inspection hole (not A190)

Check thickness and condition of brake pads & discs front and rear

Check condition of tyres

Measure tread depth and enter in mm

## Vehicle Underbody - Visual check

### Leakage - Major components

Chafed points, line route, components.

In the event of leakage, determine cause and eliminate after obtaining agreement and separate work order

Check condition of Poly Vee belt

Check condition of front suspension joints, rubber boots

Check front axle joints for play - check rubber boots

Condition of steering seals, track rod and drag link ends, rubber boots

Check condition of rear axle joints and rubber boots

Check play at long. control arm bearing - up to VIN 515389

Check condition of rear trailing arm bushes (WIS ref S100.20-P-0004B)

Inspect bolts of steering shock absorbers for tightness & leaks

(Model 215 up to VIN 007961, model 220 up to VIN 137742)

## Engine Compartment - Visual check

### Leakage - Major components

Chafed points, line route, components.

In the event of leakage, determine cause and eliminate after obtaining agreement and separate work order

Change engine oil & filter

### Check & correct fluid levels

Check cooling system, corrosion inhibitor
